The courses we offer will help you to learn foreign languages. They are available to all students at the University of Applied Sciences Augsburg. We offer language courses at all levels of the CEFR (A1 - C2) so you are sure to find a course that is consistent with your class schedule.

At the Center for Languages and Intercultural Communication, which is part of the Faculty of Liberal Arts and Sciences, the majority of lecturers are native speakers who make use of modern, activity-oriented methods.

To a certain extent, the courses are integrated into the module plans of the compulsory component of individual degree programs. What's more, most courses can also be taken as general required elective subjects.

In order to meet your needs during your studies, the courses at the Center for Languages and Intercultural Communication take place both during the semester and in blocks as intensive study courses during the semester break.

Refresher and intermediate courses will get you back up to speed

A proficiency level of B1 is required for all compulsory English courses, not only in international degree programs. Our catch-up courses will help you get up to speed and enable you to make a successful start to your studies.

Specialist language courses (business, technology) as compulsory modules of degree courses

These courses are tailored to the content of the individual degree programs and will provide you with professional language skills for your degree program and later professional life.

Fancy learning a new language?

Sometimes, good basic knowledge of rare languages can open the door to a semester abroad or even your first job.

Internationally recognised language certificates

It is often the case that the grade on your certificate alone is not enough. Get people talking about you with internationally recognised language certificates.

Planning to do a study semester or practical semester at one of our partner universities in another country?

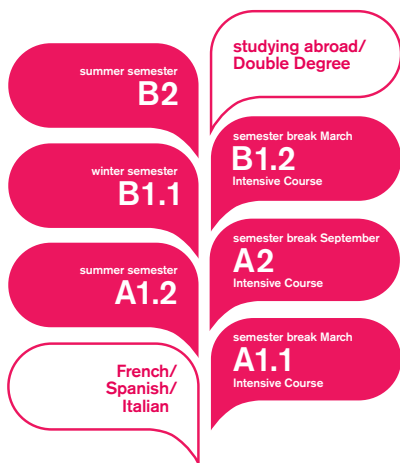
By taking advantage of the courses we offer, you could learn the language of your host country and acquire the knowledge required for studying abroad.

From zilch to B2 in three semesters

With the intensive study course concept we have at the Center for Languages and Intercultural Communication, you could get to language level B2 within 18 months. You will take standard courses during the semester as well as intensive study courses during the semester break and obtain the language certificate for studying abroad after only three semesters.

Key skills for a globalised world of work
