

Augsburg University of Applied Sciences is located in the heart of Augsburg, one of the oldest cities in Germany.

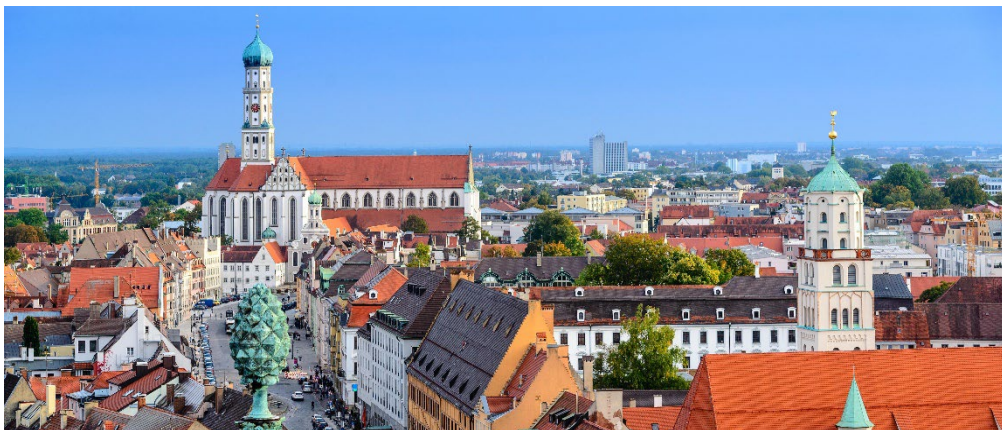

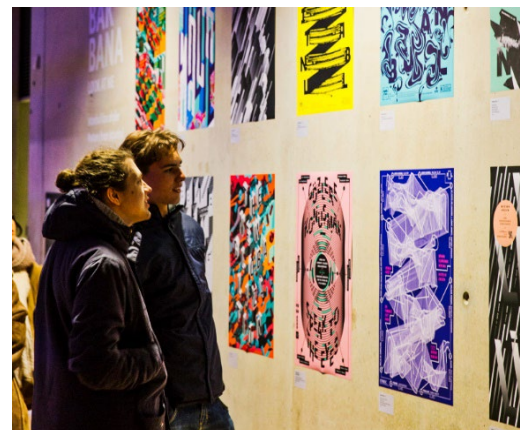

\*There is a selection of vegetarian and vegan food.

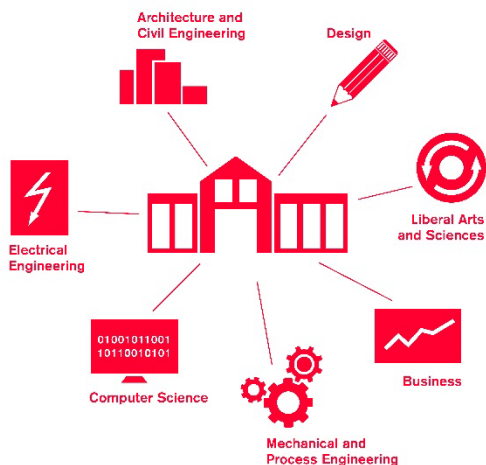

## Application

### Online Application

To participate in our exchange program, your home university has to nominate you. Afterwards, you will receive an email with a link to Mobility-Online, where you have to apply. You can find all the necessary information and application deadlines online.



### Learning Agreement

Alongside other required documents, you need to upload your Learning Agreement in the Mobility-Online portal. There is a variety of courses offered in English each semester. You can choose courses from different faculties.



### German & Intercultural Competence Courses

### Orientation Week

### Enrollment



In consultation with your International Faculty Coordinator, you can choose your courses. Once you arrive at AUAS, you log into Moodle to register for them. Moodle is the main platform, where you can find general course information and apply for courses.

## Student Welcome & Orientation Program



SWOP stands for "Student Welcome and Orientation Project". The team consists of voluntary German students, supporting Exchange Students during their time at Hochschule Augsburg. 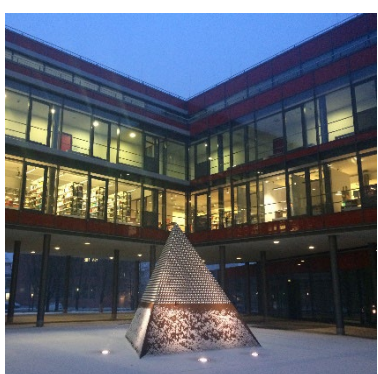
## Student Campus Card

Once you arrive at AUAS, you will receive your student card. To receive and use this card, you have to pay a small student fee beforehand and validate it at the university campus. With this card, you have access to the university; you can buy food at the canteen and use public transportation in the center of Augsburg.

## Accommodation

AUAS does not own any halls of residence itself. However, we will try to assist you in finding an accommodation in Augsburg.

### Student Dormitory

Most of the international students rent a room in one of the student dormitories. They are furnished and affordable. The rooms include a bathroom, small kitchen area and living area. Although, not all residences are near the campus, AUAS is easy to get to with public transportation.

Please note, that there is a limited capacity of apartments available for Incoming Exchange Students of AUAS. Students from overseas partner universities and those, who need a visa for entering Germany to study at AUAS, will be served first. Due to the rest of the capacities, we will distribute the rooms by first come, first serve.
